Green Valley Hosts ICORE Match

GVRPC will be hosting an Introductory ICORE Match on November 1^{st} at 9am.

The International Confederation of Revolver Enthusiast is an action shooting sport that combines elements USPSA, Steel Challenge and Bianchi into a demanding competition exclusively for revolvers. The standard paper target (moving and stationary) is the NRA D-1 target with 4 scoring areas, as well as steel. Scoring is based on a time plus scoring method that places emphasis on accuracy.

To compete you will need a revolver in safe condition of the proper caliber, a secure holster that will cover the trigger, and at least 3-4 loaders and loader holders attached to the gun belt. The shooter may load from the pocket for the initial Load & Make ready prior to the beginning of the course of fire. However, during the course of fire all reloads must come from the belt, unless otherwise directed by the course of fire. OPEN DIVISION: Revolvers must compete in this division if it has one or more of the following modification: compensating, venting, or metering ports of any kind; an optical sight including telescopic and red dot sights.

LIMITED DIVISION: Revolvers may compete in this division if it does NOT have any of the modifications listed above.

CLASSIC DIVISION: Revolver that has the following additional requirements: cylinder with only 6 chambers, any barrel other than an unaltered factory barrel or an unaltered factory replacement barrel made by the revolver's manufacturer is NOT allowed in Classic Division. Alterations to the barrel other than what is required to safely install the barrel are not permitted. An under lug, barrel weight, grip weight, or any other modification designed to increase the weight of the revolver is not permitted. Must only use speed loaders to reload. Moon-clips are prohibited.
