
Name:	The Midsouth Shooters Crawfish Cup
Date:	April 22 & 23, 2016
Schedule:	Early check-in is requested and will be available on Monday through Thursday, April 18-21; from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. and Friday from 7:00 a.m. until 3 p.m. Saturday Check-in will be at 7:00 a.m. Shooter's meeting for the Aggregate Match on Friday and Championship match on Saturday matches will begin at 7:30 a.m. Shooting begins at 8:00 a.m. Range Staff may shoot for match score on Wednesday, Thursday or Friday.
Location:	5720 Old Camp Road, Bell City, LA. SW Louisiana Rifle & Pistol Club range on LA Hwy 27 at Holmwood, LA. (1/2 mile South of the intersection of LA Hwy 14 and LA Hwy 27)
Categories:	Regional Championship: Competitors may fire in one of the following categories: Open, Metallic Sight or Production in Centerfire; or Open Rimfire, Metallic Sight Rimfire or Production Rimfire.
	Two-Gun Aggregate: There will be an optional Two-Gun Aggregate this year. In the Aggregate, competitors may fire in one of the remaining categories in the same gun type as their Championship gun, i.e. Centerfire or Rimfire.
Schedule:	The Aggregate Match will be fired on Friday morning and will be limited to 40 competitors. Practice will begin upon completion of the Aggregate Match. Note this match will take precedent over practice. Lunch on Saturday will be provided at the range courtesy of Big Daddy's Sports Grill
Eligibility:	Open to the public. Competitors under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
Rules:	Current NRA Action Pistol Shooting Rules for will govern.
Entry Info:	Entry closes at 5:00 pm on <i>Thursday, April 21, 2016</i> . Entries received on or after April 1, 2016 will not receive a T-shirt as these must be ordered in time to ensure delivery.
Entry Fees:	Regional Championship Entry Fees Regular Entry: (received before April 1, 2016) \$95 Late Entry (received on or after April 1, 2016) \$120 Junior Entry: \$60 Aggregate Match: \$40 No refunds after April 4, 2016.
Challenges & Protests:	The fee to challenge one's own target is \$10. The fee to protest another competitor's target is \$20
Classification:	Rule 19.1 Classified Competitors: NRA Action Pistol Classification will be used. Rule 19.4 Temporary Classification or Rule 19.6- assigned Classification may be used. Rule 19.2 Unclassified Competitor: Shooters that are unclassified in any discipline will compete in Master Class.
Equipment:	Revolvers and semi-automatic pistols compete together. Eye and ear protection is mandatory for all shooters and spectators. Minimum Caliber in Open, Metallic Sight and Production Classes is 9mm. Ammunition must meet a power factor of 120,000. Rimfire will compete against Rimfire only. Rule 3.12, holsters must be practical, safe, and serviceable and suited to the pistol used. Holsters must retain the pistol during any activity.

Courses:	The Regional Championship will consist of an aggregate of the Practical Event, the Barricade Event, the Moving Target Event (Mod.) and the Falling Plate Event
	The Aggregate Championship will consist of an aggregate of the Practical Event, the Barricade Event, the Moving Target Event (Mod.) and the Falling Plate Event fired with both the Primary and Secondary Guns. There will be separate Aggregate Championships for Centerfire and Rimfire firearms.
Targets:	Rule 4.2: NRA AP-1 cardboard targets will be used in turning target mechanisms on the paper events. Rule 4.3: 8" diameter round steel plates, .375" thick will be used in the Falling Plate Event. In the event of a failure of range equipment, back-up timing will be accomplished using a timer.
Squadding	The match will be squadded. Squadding schedules will be issued at Competitor Check-in.
Competitor's Duties:	Each competitor will be required to act as range safety officers for the alternate relay of their squads.

Club Awards: (Including cash)	Top Three Overall finishers will be eligible for Class Awards.
	There must be a minimum of 3 entries in a class for one award; a minimum of 7 for 2 awards; and a minimum of 12 for 3 awards. If there are fewer than 3 High Masters entered, they must fire for open awards only. Other classes may be combined to reach the minimum.
	*All cash awards are based on entries and sponsor donations. Amounts will be posted at the range after entries have closed.
	A Regional Champion will also be declared in the following categories even if there is only one entry in the category: Ladies Champion, Junior Champion (max age 20), Senior Champion (min age 60), and Grand Senior (min. age 70)
Sponsored Awards:	For the first time, we are soliciting Event and Category Sponsors. Additional Sponsored Awards, if any, will be publicized, posted on www.crawfishcup.net and posted at the range.
Prizes:	It is anticipated that there will be merchandise prizes donated that will be distributed from a prize table by random drawing at the conclusion of the tournament.
Practice:	The range will be open Monday through Thursday, April 18 through 21 from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., and on Friday, April 22 from 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. Practice fee is \$10 per day. Targets are available for sale. Match check-in is available and encouraged at the practice sessions. Range Officers will be shooting their match scores on Wednesday, Thursday or Friday beginning at 8:00 a.m. Additional practice sessions <i>may</i> be available by special request. Water will be furnished on practice days. Soft drinks are available from a vending machine.
Range Rules:	Pistols will be permitted on the range only when holstered or cased. Sight pictures will be permitted only at the firing line and at the direction of the Range Officer. The Rifle Range will be provided for practice draws, function firing, cleaning and repair. There shall be no handling of firearms except on the firing line or in the safe area. You may, while at your vehicle, transfer your unloaded pistol from its case to your holster and vice versa. This is the only gun-handling allowed in the parking area.
Facilities:	The range is equipped with portable toilets. There is no running water. Drinking water will be provided on practice days. Lunch, water and soft drinks will be furnished on match day free of charge. <i>No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the premises.</i>
Friday Night Meal	There is an optional, informal Dutch treat dinner at a locally-owned restaurant, Big Daddy's Sports Grill, on Friday evening for all shooters and their families. Great crawfish and American food! Please notify match director by noon on Friday of your intentions to attend so we may reserve enough table space. (Requested but not mandatory)
Hotels:	There are numerous hotels in the Lake Charles area. Hotels along I-210 (the South Lake Charles Loop) are closest to shopping, restaurants and casinos, and are about 20-25 minutes from the range. Hotels along I-10 in Sulphur are about 30-35 minutes from the range. Please check <u>www.crawfishcup.net</u> for more hotels.
	We are working on acquiring some hotels with special rates.
Local Flavor:	An exciting airboat tour on the Atchafalaya Swamp, along I-10 about 80 miles east of Lake Charles, is highly recommended and may be arranged individually. We recommend the airboat tour operated by <u>www.basinlanding.com</u> .

From East of Lake Charles, exit I-10 at exit 36; go South on LA 397 until it intersects with LA 14. Turn left and head East on LA 14, toward Holmwood, and follow the directions above.
